Highway View Farm is a 3<sup>rd</sup> generation dairy operating in Boscawen, NH. With a milking herd size of 200 holsteins they also farm 600 acres. The majority of their cropland is along the Merrimack River. Adam Crete has been converting this land to no-till in an effort to reduce labor and improve soil health. There have been some challenges along the way, as well as some unforeseen benefits.

#### Bohanan Farm

We are a  $5^{\text{th}}$  generation dairy farm that has been in operation since 1907. With each generation we have grown our land base and expanded our herd numbers. Today we are milking 190 registered Holsteins as well as a few Brown Swiss. Currently our rolling herd average is 29,391 pounds with a 3.6 fat and 3.0 protein average. With the 5<sup>th</sup> generation of all three boys wanting to come home, we had to either grow the herd again or market our own product to support the four families. With the limited land base in the area, the farm realized we could not milk 800-1.200 cows and we decided to market our own product. In 2011 Jamie stepped out to market glass bottled milk in order to bring all three boys home. After eight years of processing off site Contoocook Creamery has finally opened their own bottling plant as of May 2019! Moving forward we hope to grow the Creamery side of the business and at least double our output to roughly 150,000 lbs. Bohanan Farm, coupled with Contoocook Creamery, is always striving to ensure sustainable practices that will leave a more progressive and diverse farm business for future generations.
